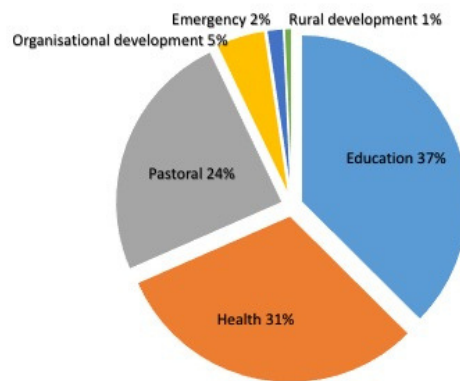

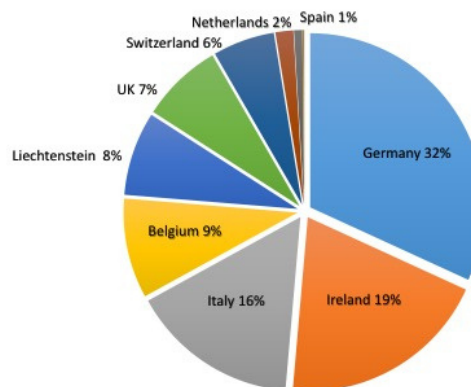

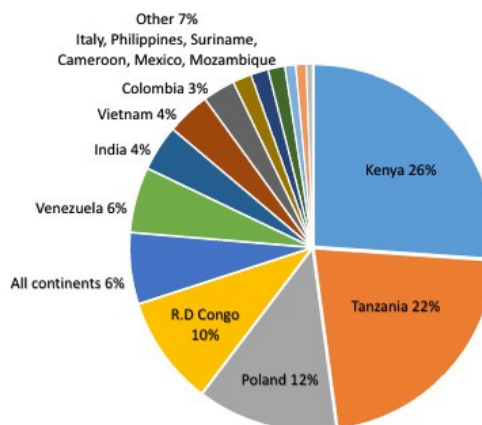
## TYPE OF PROJECTS



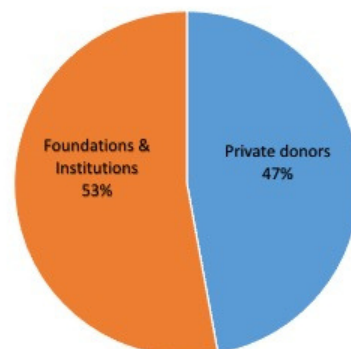
## ORIGIN OF GRANTS
