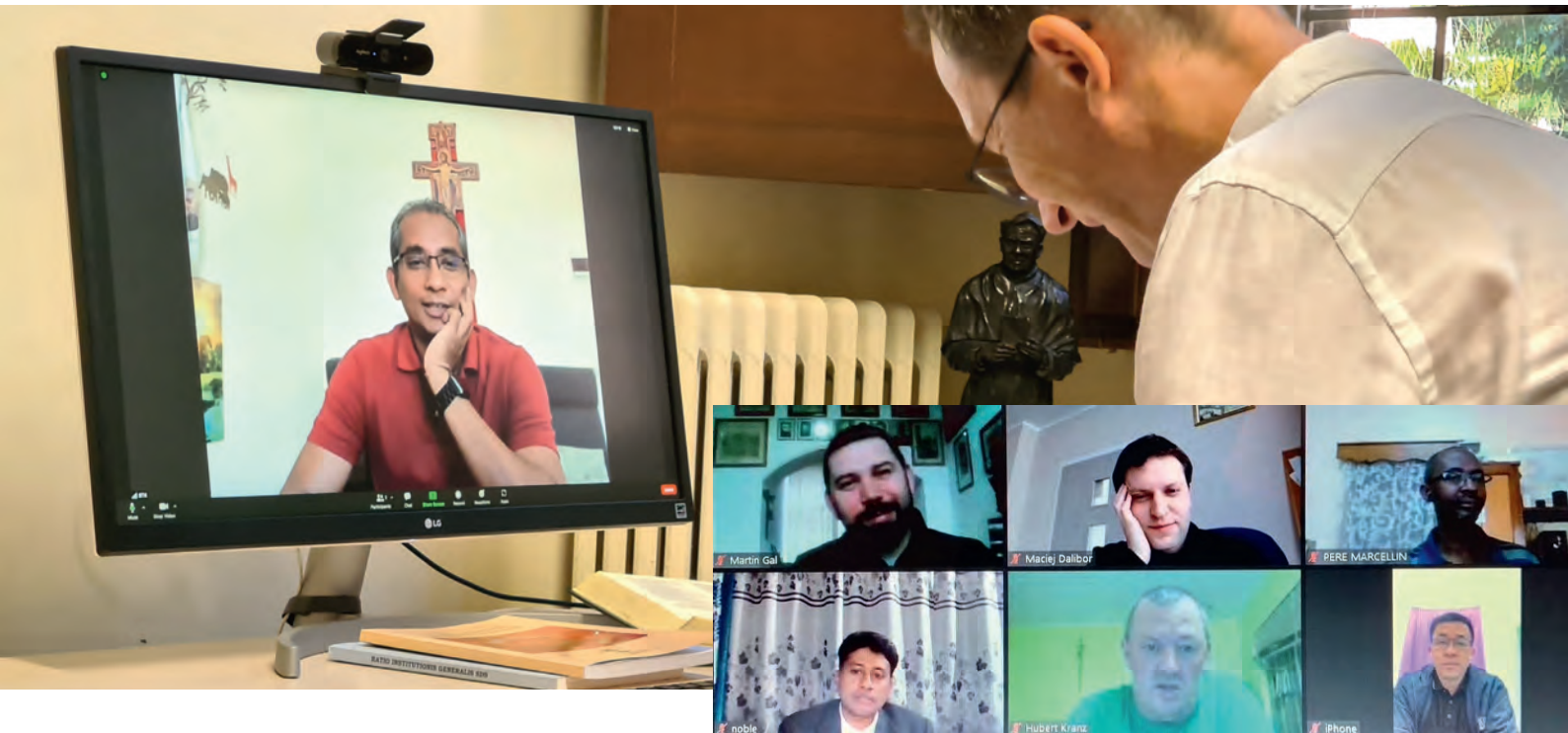




INTEGRATIVE COURSE FOR SALVATORIAN FORMATORS DURING THE “YEAR OF BLESSED FRANCIS JORDAN”



INTRODUCTION:

The promulgation of our Ratio Formationis Salvatorianae and the “Year of Blessed Francis Jordan” within the pandemic situation have been provoking to enter into a deeper process of spiritual discernment. In other words, we find ourselves asking, what the Holy Spirit is inspiring us to do in our discernment process today? This truly requires engagement of our whole person to respond constructively to this formative experience – the so called docibilitas.

Therefore, one of the Generalate’s proposals for this special „Year of Blessed Francis Jordan” is a course which encourages formators to attune themselves to this sacred voice within them. The goal of this course is to focus on our Salvatorian Formation that is articulated in the Ratio. It is to challenge our personal and communal models of formation and become people formed in consonance with the spirit and apostolic mission of Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan.

PARTICIPANTS:

All Salvatorian formators accepted by the superior of a unit and by the Preparatory Committee of the course

OBJECTIVES:

The program is to be two-fold:

As the first level:

- To acquire competence in understanding the integrative dimension of formation
- To discern and identify deficiencies and to apply the necessary strategies that work toward resolutions

As on the second level:

- To stress the Salvatorian foundational value of universality
- To raise up the profound importance of Salvatorian formation
- To foster a deeper awareness of Salvatorian formation in all aspects of religious life

WHAT IS NEEDED:

A computer, an internet camera, Zoom software, and internet connection

METHODOLOGY:

Introduction: there will be an introduction to the course (on the personal level and on the level of all participants) and an explanation of the program, the dynamics, and a Q&A session.

Personal effort: all assigned persons will be asked to commit to participation in all the meetings. During the course, each of the participants will be asked to have a personal meeting with his mentor, supervisor or spiritual director during the month. In addition, each person will present a three (3) page paper based on a chosen Salvatorian topic.

Group work: people will be divided into small groups for sharing. In addition, each group will present a three (3) page paper based on a chosen Salvatorian topic.

Whole course: All participants are to participate in each session of training. The conferences will be in the following languages: English, Spanish, French. Simultaneous translation will be provided.

Evaluation: At the end of the course, there will be time for evaluation

Conclusion: At the end of the course, each participant will receive a certificate indicating the hours of participation in the lectures.
